### Registration

Pre-registration will be available through bikereg.com and will be open through Thursday, July 7th @ 11pm. Any registration after this time will not receive the early registration discount.

Pre-registration participants can pick up their transponders & race packets beginning 1 hour prior to first TT racer @ Davidson Community College.

Onsite registration will open 1 hour before each day's racing (late fees apply) payable via cash, check or Credit Card (Visa, MC, DISC). \$5 late fee/race will be assessed. (exceptions for 2nd crit entered)

### The Timing Chip

As part of THE Piedmont Triad Omnium, each participant is required to have a timing transponder attached to the front fork of their racing machines. If you do not own one, you may purchase one through AMB directly or you may rent one for the weekend for a nominal \$5 fee.

When renting a transponder, you will be required to present and leave collateral at the time of rental which will be held by the registration staff until the transponder is returned. Acceptable collateral includes a valid Credit Card or drivers license. (small children are not accepted)

In addition to the timing chip, we will also capture your time manually via USAC officials. It is important that you have your race # attached properly, ride side Friday, left side Saturday & Sunday.

Timing chips must be returned upon the completion of your final event of the day. If you accidentally leave the course with your transponder, please place it in a padded envelope & mail it to: WAM Events, Inc. PO Box 182103 Casselberry, FL 32718. As a participant of THE Piedmont Triad Omnium bicycle race you agree to return the timing chip to the appropriate race official immediately following the race. If you fail to do so, you agree to pay a \$100 replacement fee if chip is not returned.

## **Parking**

Friday night & Sunday @ Davidson County Community College. Park in designated spots.

Saturday, Parking is available all around the outside of the Criterium course.

## **USAC Rules & Guidelines**

The 4th annual Piedmont Triad Omnium is governed under the rules & regulations of USA Cycling. The 2011 rulebook can be reviewed online @ [www.usac.org](http://www.usac.org).

**Field limits** as set forth in the USA Cycling guidelines will be followed without exception.

**Helmets** must be worn at all times. If you are registered for the event & you are on your bicycle without a helmet, you will be fined \$20. You will not be permitted to race until the fine is paid to the Chief Referee.

**Unsafe or unsportmanlike conduct** will NOT be tolerated. You will be disqualified.

**Wheel Pit** (Criterium only) rules apply as set forth by USAC. Wheels in Wheels out only.

**Wheel Truck** (road race only) TPO will provide a wheel truck for each field for the RR. NO personal support allowed.

## **License to Participate**

Only riders licensed by USA Cycling will be permitted to participate in the categories offered at THE Piedmont Triad Omnium. A valid License or official copy of an "Authorization" to ride must be present in order to register for the days events. Annual licenses may be purchased onsite in accordance with USAC regulations (1C11. one day licenses for beginners: Category 5 men or Category 4 women only)

## **Awards & Prizes**

**Prize money & prime pickup-** In order to pick up prize money or primes, participants must present a valid form of ID & their bib # & will be required to sign an acceptance sheet. Athletes must pick up their prize money themselves. **No prize money will be mailed. Prize money not picked up for the TT will be used as PREMIES during the Saturday Crits.**

## **CCA Juniors' Omnium Series**

THE Piedmont Triad Omnium is the second Omnium in the new CCA Juniors Omnium Points series. Points will be awarded to Category 4/5 Jrs 10-12, 13-14 & 15-17 based on results from Forest Acres, THE Piedmont Triad Omnium & The French Broad Classic. The top 3 finishers in each category will receive trophies Presented at The French Broad Classic.

## **Omnium Scoring**

★(Pts earned only through top 10 places in ALL events.(TT time will be tie breaker in case of any ties for overall Omnium pts).

★4C4. Individual Points Classification:

★(a) Placings in the points classification shall be determined by adding the points awarded at each stage. The following shall apply to the 1st to 15th places respectively in all except time trial stages: 25, 20, 16, 14, 12, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 point.

In time trial stages, the following points scale shall apply to the 1st to 10th places respectively: 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 point.

★Additional points may be EARNED by racing in an additional crit on Saturday. 1 pt for entering & finishing the additional race & 2 (total) pts for finishing in the top 5 of the second race. For example Racer A (Cat 3, age 41) is entered in the Overall Omnium for the category 3,4. He may earned 1 pt for entering (& finishing) the Masters 40+ race or 2pts for finishing in the top 5. And/or entering & finishing the Masters 35+ 3,4,5 Criterium.

★Points premes will be awarded during the Criteriums.
